DURATION: Full Time (10-month school year)

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Directly responsible to the K-12 Principal.
- Responsible for curriculum/lesson plans for the instruction of all Middle Level Math Courses.
- Responsible for record keeping of the aforementioned Math classes, i.e.: attendance, grade reports, quarterly reports, class scheduling, deficiency reports, etc.
- Participate in PLC's designed to improve K-12 Math program.
- Infuse, to the greatest extent possible, Ojibwe Language and Culture into all curriculum/lesson plans.
- Responsible for ordering classroom, curriculum, resource materials for the Mathematics department.
- Meets with parents, in conjunction with the Principal and Counselor regarding student deficiency reports, disciplinary measures and attendance.
- Act as grade level advisor.
- Works with the Home/School Coordinator and Counselor re: parents' home visits and in-school conferences.
- Engage in active communication with parents and stakeholders.
- Assists in hall monitoring, lunch duty rotation.
- Attends staff meetings.
- Assists in school events such as, but not limited to, the assemblies, powwows, student Awards Program and graduations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Wisconsin license certification 400 required, or K-8 Licensure.
- Experience teaching American Indian youth preferred.
- Must be supportive of the philosophy, concept, policy and procedures of the Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe School.
- Native American preference in employment.
