## Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe School Open positions for 2023-2024 School Year

<u>CULTURAL CONSTRUCTION/CRAFT CONSULTANT:</u> Grant funded position. \$250 per day for 8 hours. A person who has demonstrated knowledge and skills to help create traditional building and creating a variety of hands on projects that reflect traditional indigenous items for use in homes and in the field.

- Techniques to construct tools and implements used in traditional gathering and in home. Such as: Knockers, push poles, etc.
- Drum construction, drum sticks etc.
- Incorporating traditional designs into projects
  Creating designs that can be adapted to the new technology used in engraving and routing

Work with the curriculum specialist.

**OJIBWE ELDERS:** Grand funded position. \$30.00 per hour daily stipend. Hours per day based on need. Number of hours per week are optional.

Elders from the Ojibwe community who would be available to in the construction classroom up to five hours per week to provide cultural enrichment for the students within this program. Your presence would help facilitate pride in our culture and demonstrate to the students that this knowledge is important to the future of our people and communities.

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**COMMUNITY MENTORS:** Grand funded position. \$30.00 per hour daily stipend. Hours per day based on need. Number of hours per week are optional.

People from Ojibwe community who would be available to in the construction classroom to come in once a week to provide cultural enrichment and encouragement for the students within this program. Your presence would help facilitate pride in our culture and the demonstrate to the students that this knowledge is important to the future of the Ojibwe culture and our communities need people with these skills.
